

## Textured Pixie Bonnet Crochet Pattern



### Materials:

- Yarn: Approximately 60 yards of bulky (5) Yarn for smaller sizes, and approx. 90 yards for larger sizes, (I used Yarn Bee – Tender Touch for the base)
- Crochet Hook: Size 6.0 mm (J/10) OR whatever size is needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn or Tapestry Needle

### Abbreviations:

- SC: Single Crochet
- FPSC: Front Post Single Crochet
- TW: Turn Work
- \*\*: Repeat the section in between the two stars as specified

### Gauge:

6 sts and 8 rows = 2 inches (5 centimeters)  
in Single Crochet

\*\*\*It is important to check your gauge!\*\*\*

### Average Head Circumference:

Newborn: 13-14"  
0-3 Months: 14-15"  
3-6 Months: 14-17"  
6-12 Months: 16-19"  
1-3 Years: 18-20"

## **Newborn Pattern**

Chain 41

Row 1: SC into each stitch across, CH1, TW (40 total sts)

Row 2: FPSC each stitch across, CH1, TW (40 total sts)

Rows 3&4: Repeat rows 1&2

Continue to repeat rows 1&2 until your piece measures approx. 5" (12.75cm) from the starting edge. End on a repeat of row 1.

Fold your work with right sides together, and single crochet a seam up the back. You should put a single crochet into the two stitches across from each other, making 20 total single crochet sts.

Turn your work right side out again.

Cut three strands of yarn approx. 38 inches long and pull them in a loop through a front corner of your project. Pull the ends of the yarn through this loop (this attaches the yarn without any knots, and makes your project look smoother). Separate the yarn into three sections and braid them to desired length. Secure and cut yarn evenly on the ends. Repeat on the other side of the hood as well.

## **0-3 Month Pattern**

Chain 45

Row 1: SC into each stitch across, CH1, TW (44 total sts)

Row 2: FPSC each stitch across, CH1, TW (44 total sts)

Rows 3&4: Repeat rows 1&2

Continue to repeat rows 1&2 until your piece measures approx. 5.5" (14cm) from the starting edge. End on a repeat of row 1.

Fold your work with right sides together, and single crochet a seam up the back. You should put a single crochet into the two stitches across from each other, making 22 total single crochet sts.

Turn your work right side out again.

Cut three strands of yarn approx. 38 inches long and pull them in a loop through a front corner of your project. Pull the ends of the yarn through this loop (this attaches the yarn without any knots, and makes your project look smoother). Separate the yarn into three sections and braid them to desired length. Secure and cut yarn evenly on the ends. Repeat on the other side of the hood as well.

### **3-6 Month Pattern**

Chain 49

Row 1: SC into each stitch across, CH1, TW (48 total sts)

Row 2: FPSC each stitch across, CH1, TW (48 total sts)

Rows 3&4: Repeat rows 1&2

Continue to repeat rows 1&2 until your piece measures approx. 6" (15.25cm) from the starting edge. End on a repeat of row 1.

Fold your work with right sides together, and single crochet a seam up the back. You should put a single crochet into the two stitches across from each other, making 24 total single crochet sts.

Turn your work right side out again.

Cut three strands of yarn approx. 38 inches long and pull them in a loop through a front corner of your project. Pull the ends of the yarn through this loop (this attaches the yarn without any knots, and makes your project look smoother). Separate the yarn into three sections and braid them to desired length. Secure and cut yarn evenly on the ends. Repeat on the other side of the hood as well.

### **6-12 Month Pattern**

Chain 51

Row 1: SC into each stitch across, CH1, TW (50 total sts)

Row 2: FPSC each stitch across, CH1, TW (50 total sts)

Rows 3&4: Repeat rows 1&2

Continue to repeat rows 1&2 until your piece measures approx. 6.5" (16.5cm) from the starting edge. End on a repeat of row 1.

Fold your work with right sides together, and single crochet a seam up the back. You should put a single crochet into the two stitches across from each other, making 25 total single crochet sts.

Turn your work right side out again.

Cut three strands of yarn approx. 38 inches long and pull them in a loop through a front corner of your project. Pull the ends of the yarn through this loop (this attaches the yarn without any knots, and makes your project look smoother). Separate the yarn into three sections and braid them to desired length. Secure and cut yarn evenly on the ends. Repeat on the other side of the hood as well.

## 1-3 Year Pattern

Chain 55

Row 1: SC into each stitch across, CH1, TW (54 total sts)

Row 2: FPSC each stitch across, CH1, TW (54 total sts)

Rows 3&4: Repeat rows 1&2

Continue to repeat rows 1&2 until your piece measures approx. 7" (17.75cm) from the starting edge. End on a repeat of row 1.

Fold your work with right sides together, and single crochet a seam up the back. You should put a single crochet into the two stitches across from each other, making 27 total single crochet sts.

Turn your work right side out again.

Cut three strands of yarn approx. 38 inches long and pull them in a loop through a front corner of your project. Pull the ends of the yarn through this loop (this attaches the yarn without any knots, and makes your project look smoother). Separate the yarn into three sections and braid them to desired length. Secure and cut yarn evenly on the ends. Repeat on the other side of the hood as well.

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
